- ❖ The meeting was called to order by Arlen Homer, Booster Club President, at 7:08 p.m.
- ❖ The minutes were distributed. A motion was made the minutes be accepted, the motion was seconded and the minutes were accepted at distributed.
- ❖ Lee Voigt gave the Treasurer's Report. We currently have a net worth of approximately \$21,617. A motion was made that the treasurer's report be accepted. The motion was seconded and passed.

**Guests and Coaches**

- ❖ Coach Garnica, Bowling, reported he talked about the Booster Club at his parents meeting. There was a mix up with the times so a booster rep did not make it but Coach Garnica indicated there was some interest among the parents and made the membership applications available. The season is going well so far.
- ❖ Coach Elder, Dance, reported that the dance team will be traveling to Quincey, WA, for their first competition this year on December 13<sup>th</sup>.
- ❖ Coach Templeton, Football, reported that the team is working on off season conditioning and the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Orange Crush t-shirts will be needed soon for distribution to the middle school students moving on to Kennewick High next year.
- ❖ Coach Troutman, Girls Basketball, reported that there was a jamboree last night and the team did ok. They are distributing pocket calendars and the posters will be out soon.

**Committee Reports**

- ❖ **Clothing:** Shannon Moreno, Clothing Chairperson, reported sales are going ok. She is working with Zenon to get offerings up on the new website and that should be available in the next few months.
- ❖ **Membership:** Arlen, Booster Club President, has been actively recruiting. We have ten new members so far and he will go to a bowling match soon to talk with parents about joining the booster club.
- ❖ **Concessions:** Shannon Moreno reported we made close to \$3,000 at the Prosser/Othello playoff football game. The first home basketball game will be Tuesday night at 7:30. Theresa Buckendorf is heading up basketball concession coordination with the help of Shannon and Lori Beeler.
- ❖ **Programs:** Lorna Zaback, Program Chairperson, was not in attendance. It was reported that winter pictures have been taken and Lorna is working on the coached biographies.
- ❖ **By-Laws:** No Activity.
- ❖ **Raffle:** A motion was made to increase the raffle prize "pot" to \$100 per sports season with full discretion given to the chairperson on what to award as the prize; t-shirt, gift cards etc. Julie Westermeyer, Raffle Chairperson, will announce the football winners at the next meeting.
- ❖ **Website:** Zenon Thornton brought the group up to speed on his web design progress. The website is [www.kennewickboosters.org](http://www.kennewickboosters.org). Lori Beeler will send the agenda, minutes, schedules and forms for posting on the website. Shannon Moreno will work with Zenon to get pictures of available clothing on the website.

There will be options available to do certain things like volunteer, send in a coaches request and donate funds. When we talk with potential advertisers for the program, it was decided to include their information on the website at no charge since we were so late in getting the programs out. The Dance Team sells programs but did not have many to sell during football and none so far for basketball. Julie will talk with Lorna and find out where she is with getting the programs finished and printed.

### **Old Business**

- ❖ Lee Voigt brought up that according to Article XI Amendment, Section 1, the club violated our by-laws by voting to suspend the scholarship last meeting. According to that amendment, in order to change the by-laws, "such amendments may only be recommended by the Executive Board, and shall be presented in writing and read at the regular meeting prior to the time of voting." The booster secretary will send out a notice to the club with the by-laws as they are now with a notation that we will be voting specifically on the scholarship section at the next meeting. And, to bring suggestions and be ready to discuss possible solutions to the issue of eligibility, specifically what is a "member in good standing". We will decide at the next meeting provided there is a quorum.

### **New Business**

- ❖ Ronny Coleman volunteered to talk with Tim Henderson regarding the water bottle idea.
- ❖ Tarah Troutman & Bradyn Leyde would like to sell EKV bracelets. ASB used to sell these and they would like to resume the activity as a fund raiser for the basketball teams. It does not interfere with anything the booster club does so it is ok with the boosters.
- ❖ We need to organize the storage space at the stadium so Dennis Cooper volunteered to build shelving and do a couple other fix it type things. The cost would be approximately \$150 to accomplish all the tasks. Arlen motioned the booster club set aside funds for Dennis to build shelves in the storage unit. Michelle seconded, motion passed.
- ❖ Dave Bond would like to discuss the bond issue with the booster club. He will be scheduled for the 2/4/09 booster meeting. Ronny will let him know he will be on the agenda at that meeting.
- ❖ Coach Garnica, Bowling, would like the booster club to help with expenses when the girls go to the state tournament in Tacoma in February. Typically the club helps with food when our teams go to state but because there was not enough notice, vote was tabled until next meeting. It would be approximately \$400.
- ❖ Ronny Coleman, Athletic Director, requested the booster club help with the costs of a new AED machine for the Lions Den and the reader board. Discussion was held as to how this would help our athletes and the vote was tabled until next month due to the advance notice requirement.
- ❖ We need to order new Nacho Cheese machines for the concession stands, none of them are operable.
- ❖ There was a thank you in the paper from Babe Ruth for the baseball concession stand, boosters were listed as one of the contributors.

### **Notes**

- ❖ Booster Club meetings are held at KHS the first Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. unless rescheduled due to holidays or school events. The next meeting is scheduled for January 7<sup>th</sup>, in the Library. Attending Booster meetings is the perfect opportunity to start getting involved in supporting KHS athletics.
- ❖ The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
