- ❖ The meeting was called to order by Arlen Homer, Booster Club President, at 7:05 p.m.
- ❖ The minutes were distributed. A motion was made the minutes be accepted, the motion was seconded and the minutes were accepted at distributed.
- ❖ Lee Voigt gave the Treasurer's Report. We currently have a net worth of approximately \$27,373.60. A motion was made that the treasurer's report be accepted. The motion was seconded and passed.

Guests and Coaches

- ❖ Coach Hingston reported our first home track meet will be on March 26th. They will need about 26 adults to help run the events if any booster members are available to help, be at the field at 3:45, the meet starts at 4pm. There were not a lot of kids at tryouts but Coach expects it to pick up.

Committee Reports

- ❖ **Clothing:** Shannon Moreno, Dennis Cooper and Lori Beeler attended Lion Adventure Day and the 8th grade parent night. Sales went well and the boosters made approximately \$1800. The booster members were introduced by Jack Anderson at parent night and handed out several application forms to interested parents.
- ❖ **Concessions:** We are still looking for a volunteer to run baseball concessions. The first home game is March 21st and there is lots to do to get ready. There are several people who have volunteered to help if a leader can be found. We need to move food, buy crock-pots and a hot dog maker and schedule a day to clean up and get organized.
- ❖ **Executive Board:** There will be two vacancies on the executive board for next year, one vice president position and the treasurers position. Arlen Homer is willing to step down as President if there is an interested party but will serve another year, if there is not. Cindi Home volunteered to fill the treasurers position however there is an issue with the by-laws if she is elected. The by laws state the President and treasurer cannot be from the same household. It is understood this is to avoid any financial problems since the bank account requires both signatures on checks over a certain threshold. We will discuss clarifying the by-laws to reflect this understanding at the next meeting.
- ❖ **Programs:** Lorna Zaback, Program Chairperson, reported that we have received most of the advertising money, there is about \$2,000 left to collect but she is having trouble contacting those that have not paid. She is planning to be done with the program about 3/16 if she can get rosters and pictures and will have 30-50 printed up to sell at the first baseball game. Lorna will handle sales at the baseball games; we need a volunteer to sell at track and soccer. Lee will sell programs at the Fastpitch games. For next year, most of the work needs to be done during the summer to be ready for football. Lorna would rather not chair next year but will help and has suggested a team be formed to handle sales in July & August. The fall cover this year had cool pictures and the winter/spring cover will have the State baseball photo from last year and various photos from basketball around it. Zenon will work with Lorna to integrate the banner from the website into the program and incorporate the website on as many pages as possible. Arlen volunteered to personally collect the rest of the advertising money.

- ❖ **Raffle:** Julie Westermeyer, Raffle Chairperson, drew 9 names and sent out Thank You notes with a \$10 Starbucks card to the winners; Lori Beeler, Theresa Buckendorf, Robert Karr, Dave Kleis, Cory Lester, Tim Moon, Shannon Moreno, Cris Murphy and Alfonso Najera. CONGRATULATIONS!!!
- ❖ **Website:** The website is www.kennewickboosters.org. Spring sports photos will be available soon, Coach Garnica sent in candid photos from the bowling state tournament & they have been posted on the website. Zenon has posted the spring schedules and the new membership form for 2009-2010.
- ❖ **By-Laws:** The change has been made to the scholarship language and the new version was sent to the Secretary yesterday. She will review, sign and send to Zenon for posting on the website. They will also be distributed to the membership once they are signed.

Old Business

- ❖ The scholarship applications have been updated and will be available at the activities office on 3/9/09. Michelle Bunker will get the form to Zenon for posting on the website. The due date for scholarship applications will be May 1st. There will be a meeting of the scholarship committee on Saturday at the Starbucks on 395 at 11am for anyone interested in serving on the selection committee. Any athlete is eligible...parents of applicants cannot serve on the selection committee.

New Business

- ❖ Coach Brown has a contact that can sell clothes through his website and is set up with paypal already if we decide to not go that route with our website. Arlen will give the contact information to Shannon Moreno.
- ❖ The club voted to purchase new software for the Treasurer and Cindi Homer volunteered to work with Lee to migrate her financial records over to the new program. It was decided the club will not provide a laptop for the treasurers position.
- ❖ Concessions for girls softball are available. We were asked if the booster club was interested in taking them on. In light of the fact we have been unsuccessful at finding a volunteer to run the boys baseball the club declined. Ronny will offer the opportunity to other KeHS clubs.
- ❖ The club usually donates to the Ed Toxell Scholarship Golf Tournament. Each scholarship is \$4000, we usually give \$500. We will put it on the agenda and vote next meeting.

Notes

- ❖ Booster Club meetings are held at KHS the first Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. unless rescheduled due to holidays or school events. The next meeting is scheduled for January 7th, in the Library. Attending Booster meetings is the perfect opportunity to start getting involved in supporting KHS athletics.
- ❖ The meeting was adjourned at 8:01 p.m.
