- ❖ The meeting was called to order by Arlen Homer, Booster Club President, at 7:04 p.m.
- ❖ The minutes were distributed. A motion was made the minutes be accepted, the motion was seconded and the minutes were accepted at distributed.
- ❖ Lee Voigt gave the Treasurer's Report. We currently have a net worth of \$23,766.84. A motion was made that the treasurer's report be accepted. The motion was seconded and passed.

Ronny gave us a run down on how the spring sports are doing and explained softball and baseball playoffs and standing Softball is in a three way tie and will be having tie breaker games to determine the standings. The last home track meet is tomorrow, May 7th and they need more parent volunteers to help out. The Moreno's and Geri Julian-Taylor volunteered to help. The top 30 kids will go on to Districts in Pasco, Regionals will be in Spokane. There will be a car wash on Saturday to raise funds for the track team, 10am – 2pm at Vinyard Pizza Hut.

Committee Reports

- ❖ **Clothing:** Shannon Moreno reported clothing sales are a bit slow but she expects to get busier as we move toward football season.
- ❖ **Concessions:** Julie Westermeyer reported baseball concessions have not been real busy. The Southridge game was good. We made about \$1,000 so far and may host a playoff game if we loose on Tuesday.
- ❖ **Memberships:** The new form for 2009-2010 school year is available. Anyone signing up in the spring will be a member through next spring. We will be actively recruiting new members during summer activities.
- ❖ **Programs:** Theresa Buckendorf suggested we market our program ads to the stores that the kids frequent for their athletic gear. There are still some fall programs to use as examples when asking for sponsors over the summer. Patti Elder asked for some programs and Lorna will get those to her. She will also send the list of current businesses that have been contacted so club members can start thinking about other companies we can contact. Club members should take at least one athlete in uniform with them and have them help to sell the ads. Lorna will bring some programs to the track meet tomorrow to sell. Theresa Buckendorf, Arlen Homer, Jennifer Ayers and Lorna Zaback will be on the committee.
- ❖ **Website:** We will check with Zenon to see if we can provide links to our advertiser's websites. Ronny is working on several forms he would like posted.

Julie is putting together a guide to follow for the next baseball concession person to refer to. The freezer is there and running fine. The club thanked Julie for stepping up to run the baseball concessions.
- ❖ **Scholarship:** Julie, Cindi, Shannon, Dennis & Arlen are on the scholarship committee to date. Arlen will pick up the applications and get them to Dennis tomorrow. The scholarship has to be decided by June 1.

Old Business

- ❖ Still looking for an interested party to serve as membership chair and football concession chair. There are only three home football games this year, Wenatchee, Pasco and ????. Shannon Moreno volunteered to organize football concessions.
- ❖ The club is planning to make a strong effort to recruit new members by attending clinics.

New Business

- ❖ Coach Garnica presentation to the club, the bowling team made a collage and gave it to Ronny to present to the club. It will be displayed in the Booster Window by the office.
- ❖ There is a meeting scheduled for May 20th with the district and various interested parties to cover the rules and laws for paying coaches and helpers during summer camps. Payroll should go through an accountant so it is important that the President and Treasurer be in attendance.
- ❖ Coach Leyde has asked for funds to help send the boys to basketball summer league and tournaments, \$1,125. He would like to send two teams to the Richland tournament and two teams to the Kamiaken tournament. It was motioned the club give boys basketball \$1, 125 for summer activities; the motion was seconded and carried.
- ❖ The club has been asked to provide concessions on the Friday of football camp from 1-9pm. We would be happy to do that...Ronny will send info to Shannon Moreno.
- ❖ Selling Fireworks as a fundraiser was discussed. Quite labor intensive but has the potential to be very profitable. Ronny will gather more details for us. We would need to set up a committee to coordinate this effort if the club decides to pursue it.
- ❖ Arlen will follow up with the Southridge people regarding the possibility of organizing a friendly rival basketball game as a fundraiser next year.
- ❖ Pizza Hut, Sonic and Burger King all have Fund Raiser discount cards the teams can sell if anyone is interested.
- ❖ Cross-Country will be holding a holiday bazaar in November so if you know any crafty people, pass the word. Tables will be \$35 each and the bazaar will be held in the East Gym on 11/21/09.
