- ❖ The meeting was called to order by Theresa Buckendorf, Booster Club President, at 7:07 p.m.
- ❖ The minutes were distributed. A motion was made the minutes be accepted, the motion was seconded and the minutes were accepted at distributed.
- ❖ The Treasurer's Report was read. We currently have a net worth of \$43,622.35 with \$27,577.17 in the General Booster and the balance in various team "accounts" as noted in the November Financial Statement, prepared 12/1/2009. Liabilities include \$5K for Ronny Coleman fund raising activities and \$2K for Scholarships to be awarded. A motion was made that the treasurer's report be accepted. - ❖ Coach Leyde reported the basketball team did well at the jamboree last night.
- ❖ Coach Templeton reported the team held their awards ceremony 2 weeks ago and have started conditioning for the next season. He is excited about the prospect of going 3A.
- ❖ Coach's Hingston reported the girls and boys track and cross-country have started workouts and are looking for assistant coaches for various positions. Lori Beeler will try to contact Dennis Dudley, Hanford High's pole vaulter that went to the Olympic trials back in the 70's.
- ❖ The bowling team attended the Nacho bar Classic in Moses Lake and took first place. So far they are 5-0.
- ❖ **By-Laws:** Nothing to report.
- ❖ **Clothing:** Shannon Moreno reported sales are slow right now, quite a bit less than last year. Mr. Anderson was going to put info in the Lion's Paws and on the reader board. We will check into that advertising effort. We will ask Zenon to put a blurb on the website about Lion Clothing Making Great Christmas gifts.
- ❖ **Concessions:** Shannon Moreno reported we will be getting a big credit from Coke for the cases of cups that were returned after football, about \$500 will be used up during winter sports to stock the Lion's Den pop cooler. We are ready to go with winter concessions. Geri Taylor-Julian and Theresa will be handling Wrestling on Tuesday, Theresa & Bowling will do basketball on Friday and Shannon will be handling the Bob Mars tournament on Saturday with the help of Sonja, Lori & Dennis. There are several opportunities for fund raising still available. Theresa will send out an update. Ron King will send an updated schedule and talk to the coaches about working the concession stands, reminding them there will be no financial help from the booster club once the general fund is exhausted. Each team needs to build up their "coffers" by helping out with concessions. Volleyball concession money has not yet been turned in, Cindi will contact Sonja to get that wrapped up. Concessions not spoken for by a team will be manned by the Booster Club with all proceeds going into the general fund.

- ❖ **Memberships:** Corey Lester reported we currently have 68 members, 54 voting and 14 non-voting. She will send out a new list to the Secretary.
- ❖ **Programs:** Ron King reported all the rosters are complete and pictures have been taken. He will send them to Lorna for the program. Lorna reported she should be able to have some programs put together for the December 12th double header.
- ❖ **Website:** No report
- ❖ **Scholarship:** Dennis Cooper reported he is in the process of revising the form to remove all identifiers from the application. Once that is complete, it will be sent out for distribution.

Old Business

- ❖ Melanie Hingston reported the Holiday Bazaar was a success and raised about \$1,000 for Mr. Coleman. It was fun to see all the kids from KeHS helping out, baking, decorating and entertaining the shoppers. Thank you to everyone for helping out. FFA & the Art Department also raised money for their activities.
- ❖ Fund Raising for Mr. Coleman. There will be a Spaghetti Feed in January. The 29th has no sporting event scheduled and it is a Friday night. There will be a silent auction and possibly a Raffle.
- ❖ 3A/4A Update. Mr. King reported Kennewick High qualifies for 3A standing based on enrollment. Kamiaken is on the edge so if anyone opts up to 4A who is currently a 3A school, Kamiaken will move down to 3A. We will stay 3A regardless of the other schools. Gonzaga will most likely opt up to 4A. The official notification will happen in January.
- ❖ The basketball Jamboree went fine; it was not super busy.
